Conversion of St. Paul . . .

Paul's encounter with Jesus on the road to Damascus made him realize that when he persecuted Christians, it was actually Jesus he was persecuting. After his conversion, Paul zealously and fearlessly spread the Good News, making Jesus known - His love, mercy & forgiveness.

St. Paul was converted from Judaism on the road to Damascus. He was the ultimate missionary, traveling throughout many countries and lands, preaching the Gospel of Jesus. He established numerous churches during his travels and was even imprisoned several times.

St. Paul died in the year 67.
