- ~ Baptismal Certificate

### CONFIRMATION:

- ~ Ages: 13 - 15 years
- ~ Baptized and had First Holy Communion

### MARRIAGE:

- ~ Four (4) months notice
- ~ Marriage Preparation Course (compulsory)
- ~ Initial Interview
