- ~ Baptismal Preparation Meeting with parents and sponsor (godparent)
- ~ One parent (at least) - baptized Catholic

FIRST HOLY COMMUNION: 7 - 12 years old

~ Baptismal Certificate

CONFIRMATION:

- ~ Ages: 13 - 15 years
- ~ Baptized and had First Holy Communion

MARRIAGE:

- ~ Four (4) months notice
- ~ Marriage Preparation Course (compulsory)
- ~ Initial Interview

Saint of the Week: Our Lady of Lourdes

Feast Day: Feb. 11



Our Blessed Mother appeared to a 14 year poor girl Bernadette in a cave at Massabielle near Lourdes in France in 1858. Bernadette was asthmatic and always had poor health, which caused her not being to complete her lessons to receive her 1st Holy Communion. While her other sister and friend were gathering firewood across the river, Bernadette stayed on the other side and waited for them. Alone, she saw a beautiful lady in the cave and gestured to her to pray the Rosary, and eventually asked her to return to that cave few times, which she did with many opposition including her own family. Our Lady told Bernadette her name: Immaculate Conception. The Church was built at this place at the request of our Blessed Mother and the spring water which Bernadette dug up, also at the command of our Lady has become the source for the sick a HEALING water up to this present time.
